Review Summary

95 pts – “A 51/45/4% split, vinified separately in concrete fermenters, the grenache stays as whole bunches, the other two destemmed; pressed to 2800L oak casks, blended and bottled around the 10-month mark. I like this a lot – it’s savoury, yes, good fruit the foundation but all a stepping stone. Fuller bodied, shapely, grainy tannins and juicy acidity ensure this is a bit of rock ‘n’ roll.”
